

Buildings & Grounds Committee
January 23, 2017

Present: Committee Members Scott and Fleck LeJeune; Council Members Larmore and Sovinski; Mayor Hazel; Director Hitchcock; Auditor Strawn, Bill Kincaid, The Daily Standard.

Committee Chairman Scott called the meeting to order at 6:31 pm.

CM Scott posed the question to Council Members whether or not they want a sign on the building. All members replied yes. The majority of the members recommended a sign be placed just on the front of the building. The next question CM Scott posed is what it should say. CM Sovinski suggested putting up a Celina City logo with Administration Building lettering. Mayor Hazel stated he likes the idea of having a large logo on the building with the lettering. General consensus of council is to put lettering on the front of the building only; a full colored Celina seal, with an option of no color; black (or dark) upper and lower case lettering; option for backlit with LED lighting or spotlight; and the letters centered symmetrically. Director Hitchcock will get with the sign company for design to go out for bid.

Chairman Scott adjourned the meeting at 6:54 pm.
